Wāween kein kar iooni kōn imwe im jar rejjab jeja ilo Kabuñ. Rej mōttan māndenlōk ko Jemedwōj Ilañ eaar litok ñan kōj.

Ejjelōk Baba enaaj jilkinlōk ajri ro Nejin ñan juōn āne ettolōk im kauwatata ñan mour ilo juōn tōrein melijoñ ijo emōj jelā kake bwe Lucifer ewōr an anemkwōj ñan makūtküt ilo an jab lelōk mōkta ñan er juōn kajoor in kōjparok an juōn make. E enaaj kar barāinwōt kake ñan er kōn wāween ekōnono Ippān jān Jeme ñan ajri eo im jān ajri eo ñan Jemen. Aolep ajri ro nejin Jemed eaar jilkintok ñan lał in ej letok Jetōb eo an Kraist, ak Meram eo an Kraist.¹ Jej, ejjelōk iaad, kar kōmake lōk ijin kōn ejjelōk kōjatdikdik kōn tōl im lōmōr.

Jān jeje ko rekwojarjar, kōj jej jelā kōn Kweilōk eo Eļap Ilañ im kālet eo ñan jilkintok laddik ro im leddik ro nejin Anij ñan mour ilo lał in ñan bōk ānbwin im ñan melijoñ. Kōj jej ajri ro nejin Anij. Ewōr juōn jetōb ilo ānbwinid ej jōkwe ie, ñan kiiō, ilo juōn ānbwin in kanniōk. Jeje ko rekwojarjar rej jiroñ kōj, “Kom̄ jab jelā ke bwe kom̄ tempel an Anij, im Jetōb an Anij ej jokwe ilo kom̄?” (1Korint 3:16).

Āinwōt ajri ro nejin Anij, Kōj jej katak bwe jej mōttan” karōk in mōnōñō eļap” (Alma 42:8).

Jej jelā bwe eaar wōr juōn Tarinae ilo Lañ, im Lucifer im ro raar lōor e kar jołok er ilo an ejjelōk ānbwinier:

Satan, jerbenit eo, aeet devil eo,...eaar jum̄ae Anij, im pukōt ñan bōk aełōñ in kiiñ eo an ad Anij im an Kraist—

Kōn menin, eaar kōm̄māne tarinae eo ippān armej ro rekwojarjar an Anij, im eaar jepool er (D&C 76:28–29).

Kar letok ñan kōj anemkwōj in kālet. Jej aikuj kōjerbale ilo jim̄we im pād wōt ilo ad epake Jetōb eo, elāññe ejjab jenaaj liakelōk kōj make ilo jajełokijeñ ñan kabō ko an ri jum̄ae eo. Jej jelā bwe kōn Pinmuur eo an Jisōs Kraist emaroñ karreoiklōk bōd ko ad , im ānbwinid enaaj bar rool ñan jōkjōk eo ewāppen.

“Bwe lo, Jetōb in Kraist emōj lelōk e ñan aolep armej, bwe en maroñ jelā em̄man jān nana; kōn menin, ij kwalōk wāween eo ñan ekajet; bwe men otemjełok ej karuwainene ñan kōm̄māne em̄man, im ñan kareel ñan tōmak ilo Kraist, kar jilkinlōk e jān kajoor eo im men in lelōk eo an Kraist; kōn menin kom̄ maroñ jelā kōn juon jelāłokjen eweppān e ej jān Anij.” (Moroni 7:16).

Ewōr juōn wāween ekōnono ewāppen kōn Jetōb, “bwe Jetōb ej kappukot men otемjej, aaet, men ko re m̄wilal an Anij.”(1 Korint 2:10).

Ālkin wōt peptaij tok ñan Kabuñ eo an Jisōs Kraist im Armej ro Rekwojarjar ilo Raan Kein Āliktata, ej itok kaiñi eo kein karuo: “Likit ba ko ion board ñon bōk men in letok eo an Jitōb Kwojarjar” (Lajrak in Tōmak ko 4:1).

Ainikien eo em̄jan, im dik in im̄we ej itok āinwōt juōn eñjake jān an kōm̄jan āinwōt juōn ainikien. Jelāłqjeñ eo em̄ool emaroñ kōnono ilo lōm̄nak. Iaar jerbal ilo elōñ iiō ko ilo Doulul eo an Joñoul Ruo Rijilōk ro ippān Elder LeGrand Richards. Eaar mej ilo joñan iiō ne 96. Eaar jiroñ kōm bwe ke eaar juōn laddik 12 an iiō eaar pād ilo juōn kweil̄ok elāp. Ilo ijo eaar roñjake Būreejtōn Wilford Woodruff.

Būreejtōn Woodruff eaar kwal̄ok kōn juōn iien kar im̄we kōn eñjake eo jān Jetōb. Būreejtōnji eo Kein Kajuñan eaar jilkinl̄ok e ñan “kakobaik aolep armej ro rekwojarjar an Anij ilo New England im Canada im bōktok er ñan Zaion.”⁷

Eaar bōjrak ilo m̄weo im̄on juōn iaan em̄jaan ro ilo Indiana im likūt diaka eo waan ilo melān eo ijo e im kōrā eo ippān im juōn iaan ajiri ro raar etal im kiki ilo an ro jet uwaan baamle eo an raar kiki iloan m̄weo. Ejjab to jān ke eaar kakije ilo boñōn eo, Jetōb eaar unoojdikdik, ñan kakkōl e, “Jutak, im kōmakūt diaka eo waam.” Eaar jutak im kar kōmakūt diaka ettol̄ok jān ijo eaar jutak ie. Ke eaar bar rool ñan kiki, Jetōb eaar bar kōnono ñan e, “Il̄ok im kōmakūt menin mour ko am̄ ettol̄ok jān wōjke oak en.” Eaar kōm̄jane menin, innem eaar rool bar juōn alen ñan kiki.

Ilowaan wōt 30 minit tok ālik juōn kōtto eaar ukwōjłok wōjke eo me eaar lukwōj menin mour ko an raan pād ie im wōtłok ñaе ioon lał. Ekar kotake jibuki yard ko (90 m) ikōtaan ruo oror. Wōjke eo ekilep, eo kāān eaar lałem nee (1.5 m) depakpak eaar wōtłok im jejjete ioon ijo riaka eo waan eaar pād ie. Ilo an roñjaki unoojdikdik ko an Jetōb, El̄tōr Woodruff eaar maroñ kōjparok mour eo an im mour eo an lio ippān im ajri eo nejin.⁸

Ke rar kūr eō āinwōt juōn Riutiej an Kabuñ in epakeł̄ok 50 iiō ko remootłok, kōm ad jokwe ilo juōn melaj elukkuun dik ilo Utah Valley eo kōmij kar ña etan am juōn jikin am lale menin mour ko. Ekar wōr juōn nejim cow im kiria im bao im elōñ menin mour jidik ko nejier.

Juōn Jādede, iaar aikuj in kattōr łok ñan airport eo in kel̄ok ñan juōn kweil̄ok an stake ilo California. Bōtaab cow eo eaar bōroro im eaar pād ilo kauwatata. Calf eo eaar ɬotak tok, bōtaab

cow eo eaar jab maroñ jutak. Kom̄ ar kool e takto in menin mour eo, eo eaar itok. Eaar ba bwe kau eo eaar orañłok juōn weea im ejjamin maroñ mour ilowaan raan eo.

Iaar jei talboon nōm̄ba eo an kom̄pani in ej laļe mweik an menin mour bwe lio ippa en maroñ kooł e er ñan itok im bōk kau eo ālikin wōt an mej.

Mokta jān Aō kar emmakūt, kōm eaar kōm̄māne jar in baamle eo am. Ładdik eo nejūm edik ear kōm̄māne jar eo am. Ālikin an kar kajjitōk ippān Jemed Ilañ ñan “kōjeram̄mān papa ilo makutkut ko an im kōjeram̄mān kōm aolep,” eaar kaiur im akweļap. Eaar ba, “Jemed Ilañ, jouj im kōjeram̄mān Bossy cow eo bwe en maroñ em̄mān an pād.”

Ilo California, iaar ba kōn wāween in ar bōk jikin im kar ba, “Ej aikuj jelā bwe ejjab pidodo ad bōk aolep men ko jej kōnaan.”

Ekar juōn menin ekkatak, bōtaab ekar ña eo iaar katak jān e ejjab ładdik eo nejū. Ke iaar jepłak boñōn Jabōt eo, Bossy eaar “em̄mān an pād.”

Irooj eaar ba, “Inaaj ba ñan eok ilo kōlmenļokjen eo am im ilo būruwōm, kōn Jetōb Kwojarjar eo, eo enaaj itok ñan eok im enaaj jokwe ilo būruwōm. (D&C 8:2).

Im Enos eaar lōqke, “Im ke iaar eñtaan ilo jetōb, ainikien Irooj eaar bar itok ilo kōlmānļokjen eo aō” (Enos 1:10).

Komaroñ jelā kōn men ko kwōj aikuj jelā. Jar bwe kwōn maroñ ekkatak ñan bōk im̄we im pād wōt ilo mour wānōk ñan bōke. Dāpij wōt kein jerbal en—kōlmenļokjen eo am—erreo im anjo jān pok ko an laļ.

Ilo Bata eo Kein Karuo eaar pād ilo Navy eo lōk ñan China. E im bar ro jet raar etaļ kōn tireiin ñan jikin eo an Tientsin ñan etale ipēlaakin.

Tokālik, raar iuwe ilo juōn tireiin ñan jeplaak ñan base eo aer, ak ālikin eļapļok jān juōn awa tireiin eo eaar jeer tuiōn ḥok. Raar pād ilo tireiin eo ebōd! Raar jab jelā kajin China. Raar kanōk lałtak to in idiiñ eo im tireiin eo eaar bōjrak. Raar katoiek er ilo jet jikin ilo aelōn eo ilo an ejjeļok jabdewōt men ñan kōmṁane ak etał lall̄ok ñan jikin eo.

Ālikin etetal ilo jet awa ko, raar loe juōn wa paam, kain en me rijerbal ro ilo iał in tireiin ko rej kōjerbali. Raar door e ilo iał ko im pojak ñan aer paam tok ilo iał eo aer ñan iał ko. Enaaj kar wanlałłok ilo pāt eo, ak kar aikuj iuun ḥōnl̄ok ilo pāt eo.

Ke raar wanlałtak ilo pāt eo, raar koboob ilowaan wa eo im jinoe an jikāāt. Graham eaar eo āliktata ñan delōn ilowaan. Jikin eo eaar peļļok ñan e ej ilo tumaan in wa eo. Eaar kakōtköt ikijeen im āliktata tallōn ilowaan. Ke eaar kōmṁane menin, eaar tibbok im wōtl̄ok. Eaar batbat kōn likūn ilo an neen pād ikijen wa eo ñan bōbrae jān an wa eo dipōje. Ke eaar mōkajļok wa eo, eaar roñ ainikien an jinen ba, “Bud, kwōn kanooj kōjpārok!”

Wāween kein kar iooni kōn imwe im jar rejjab jeja ilo Kabuñ. Rej mōttan mādenļok ko Jemedwōj Ilañ eaar litok ñan kōj.

Juōn iaan kein jerbal ko rekkañ tata an rikōjdāt eo ej ñan kajieoñ kaboik kōj bwe jejjab kiiō erreo ñan jar. Jekdoon wōn kwe ak ta eo emōj am kar kōmṁane, kwe komaroñ jar aolep iien.

Rikanaan Joseph Smith eaar kalim̄mur bwe “aolep ro ewōr ānbwinier ewōr kajoor ippāier ioon ro ejjeļok.”⁹

Elaññe kabot ej itok, komaroñ pukōt juōn kōl ñan jołok er jān ḥōmṇak eo am—bōlen kakememej naan ko jān juōn al em̄jan tata ippam. Kōlmenļokjen̄ eo am ej eddoik, ānbwinūm ej kein jerbal eo ilo kōlmenļokjen̄ eo am. Ne jet ḥōmṇak ko rettoon rej jiktok ilo kōlmenļokjen̄ eo am, ukōti kōn kii in jołok eo am. Al eo erreo ekajoor im emaroñ jipañ eok kamadmōd ḥōmṇak ko am.¹⁰

Ke Oliver Cowdery eaar jab maroñ in kajieoñ ukok, Irooj eaar ba ñan e:

Lo, kwoj jañin meleļe; kwar ḥōmṇak bwe in kar lewaj ñan eok, ke kwar jab bōk am ḥōmṇak

ijellőkin ke kwar kajjítók ippa.

“Ak, lo, ij ba ñan eok, bwe kój aikuj katak kake ilo kólmenlökjeñ eo am; innem kwój aikuj kajjítók ippa eláññe ejimwe, im eláññe enaaj jimwe inaaaj kóm̄man bwe ubōm en bwil ilowaan, kón menin konaaj eñjake bwe menin ejimwe.

“Ak eláññe ejjab jimwe enaaj ejjelők eñjake rót in ippam” (D&C 9:7–9).

kajjitōk, im kwonaaj bōk; kōlaļlaļ, im enaaj peļļok īnan eok” (D&C 88:63).

Ijeļā Būreejtōn Monson, Ij lōmṇak, āinwōt an elōn em̄aan ro ioon laļ in jelā e, im Ij kwaļok juōn kam̄ool eo em̄ool bwe e ekar “kūr jān Anij, kōn kōnaan” (Lajrak in Tōmak 1:5). E ej aikuj jar ko ad—im kōrā eo pāleen, Frances, im baamle eo an—ilo eddo in em̄an ioon aeran.
