- An angel told **Mary**, “Thou shalt . . . bring forth a son, and shalt call his name Jesus” (Luke 1:31).



- The prophet **Isaiah** wrote about the Messiah. “For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given” (Isaiah 9:6).
