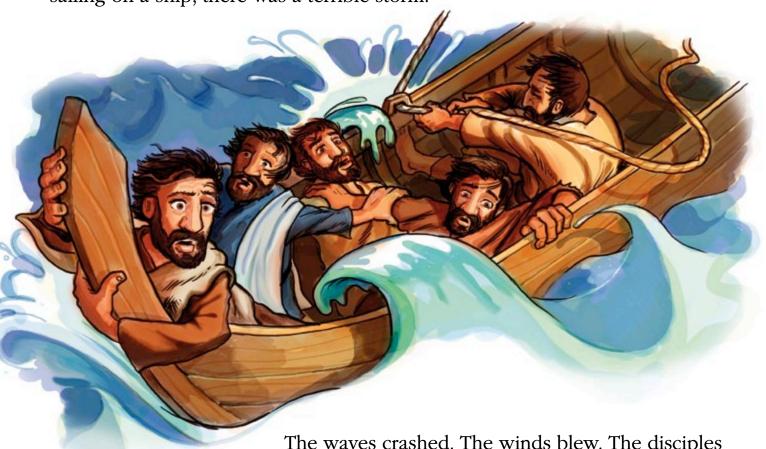
Jesus Calms the Tempest

"Why are ye fearful?" Jesus asked.

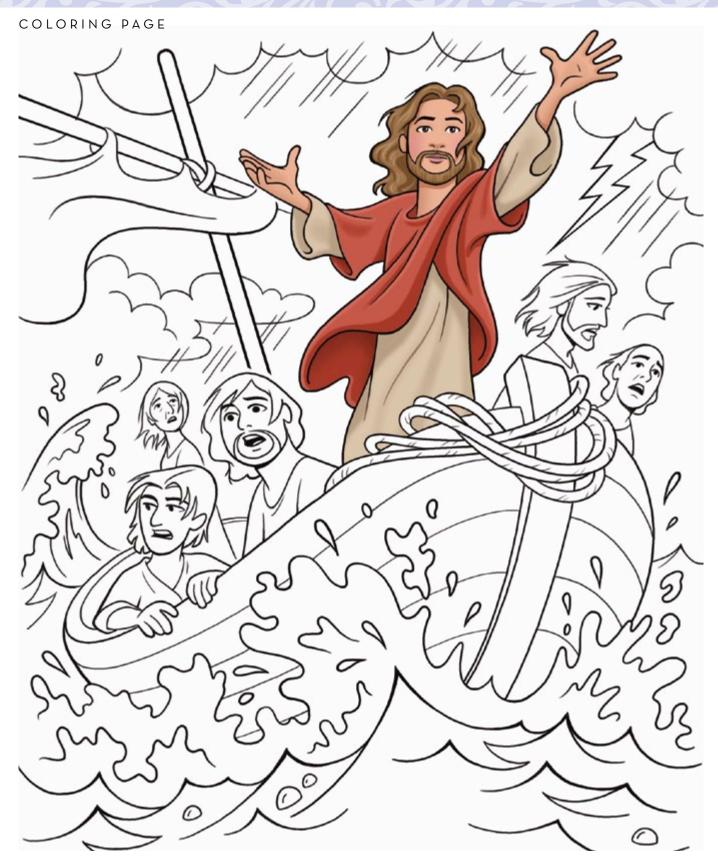
