

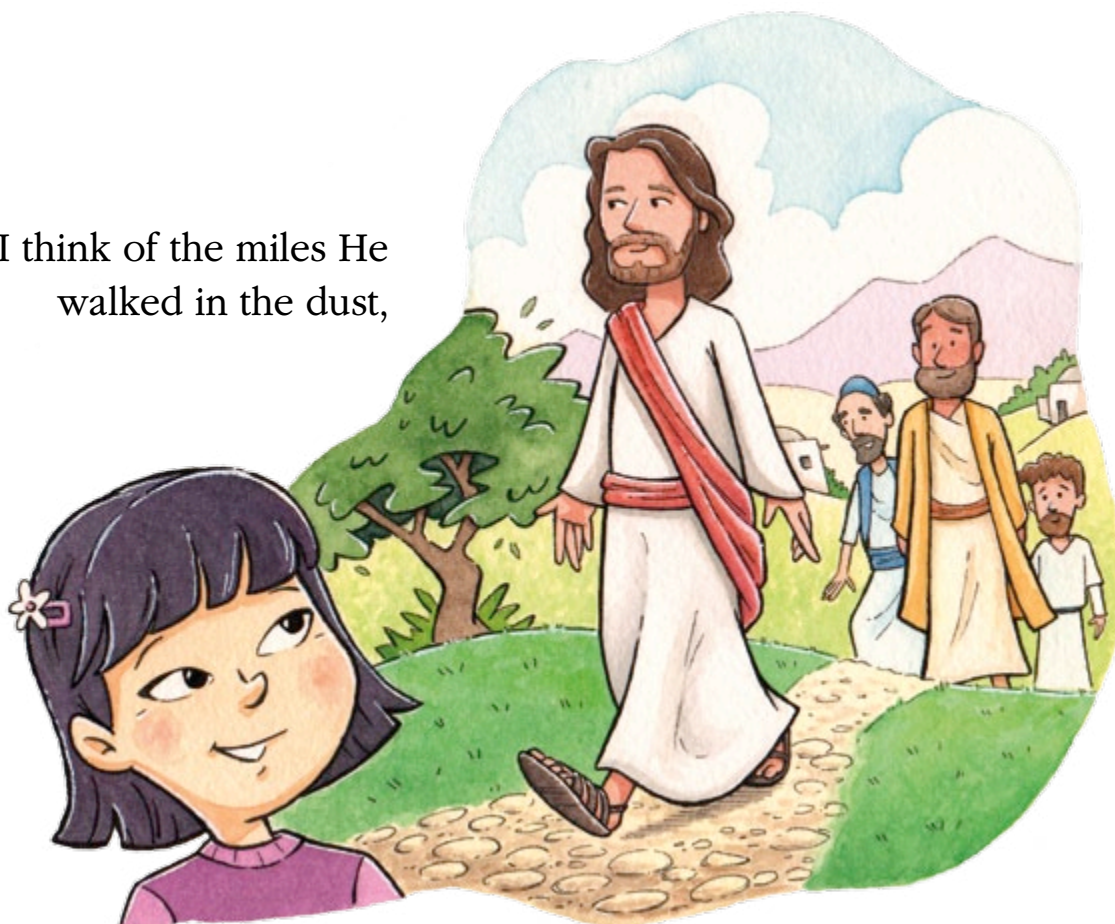
# To Think about Jesus

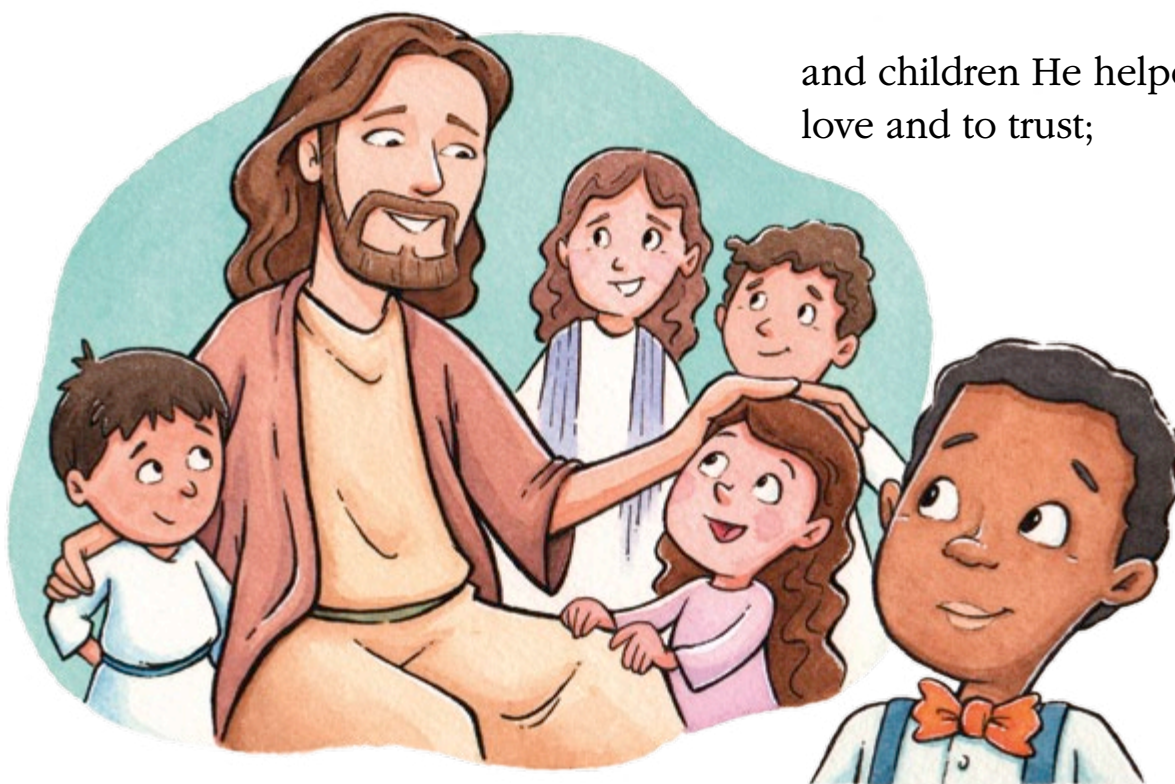


It shouldn't be hard to sit very still
