

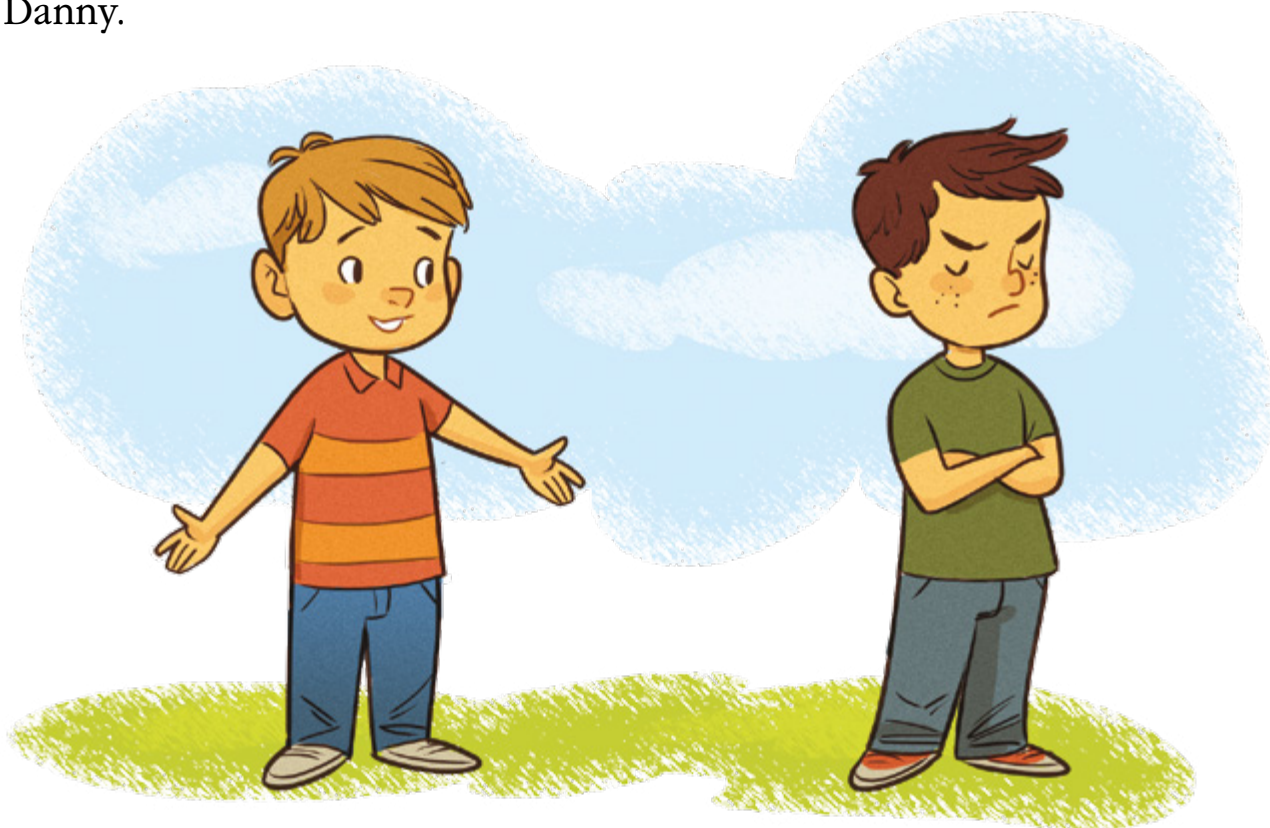
Friends for Eli
