Is everybody ready for preschool?

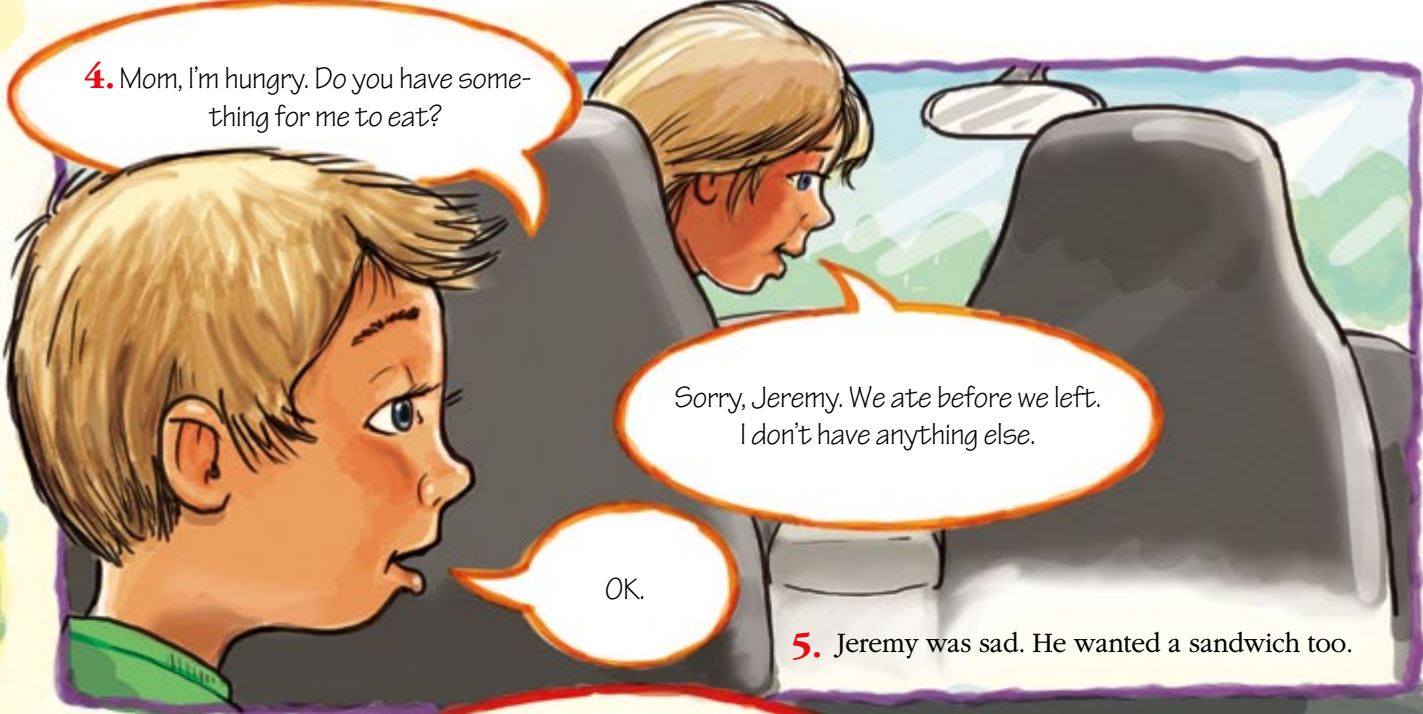
Yes!

No problem. That's what friends are for!

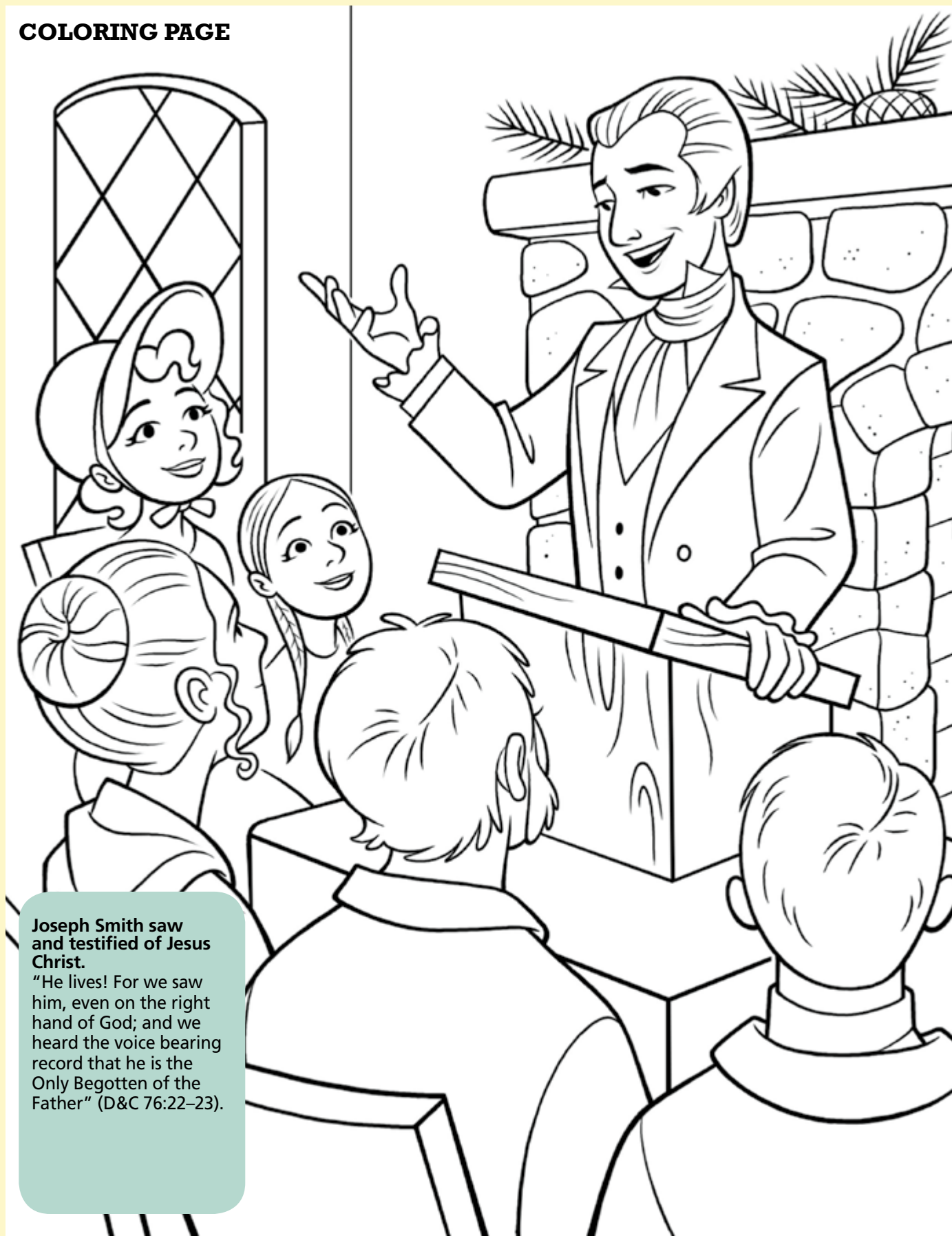


## BEING A FRIEND
