Talk about the difference in being able to complete the task and then discuss the principles found in the article.

Consider playing “scripture charades” or “scripture pictures.” Act out a scripture story or draw it on a piece of paper without using any words. Have family members guess the scripture story or people involved. You could then read about these people in the scriptures and discuss why you admire them. What characteristics of theirs do you want to develop?
