"From Generation

to Generation," p. 44: Write the following on pieces of paper, and put them in a bowl: 1 Nephi 8:12–18; 1 Nephi 10:17; 1 Nephi 15:6–11; Mosiah 17:1-4; Mosiah 18:1-3. Pass the bowl to a family member, and have him or her take a paper and read the scripture aloud. Continue until all have been read. Ask what these scriptures have in common. Discuss the importance of passing the gospel from one generation to another.

p. F12: Give each family member a picture of a puppy. Read the story about the dog, having your family listen for the person the dog was loyal to and why.
