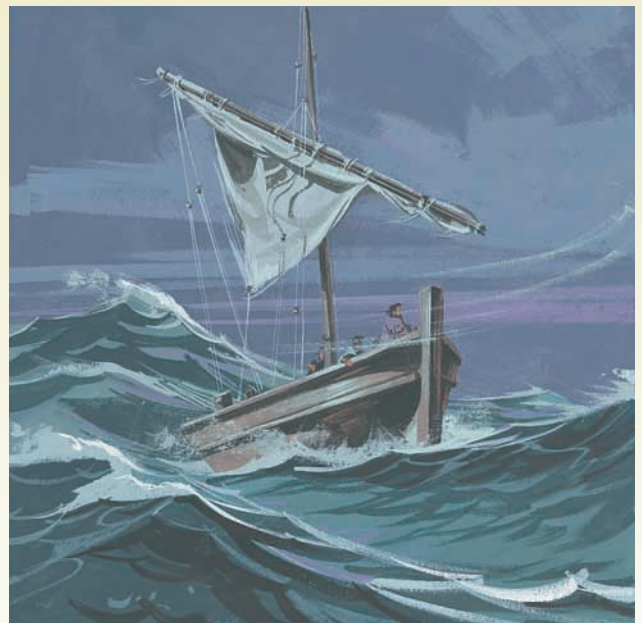




CHAPTER 29

Jesus Walks on the Water



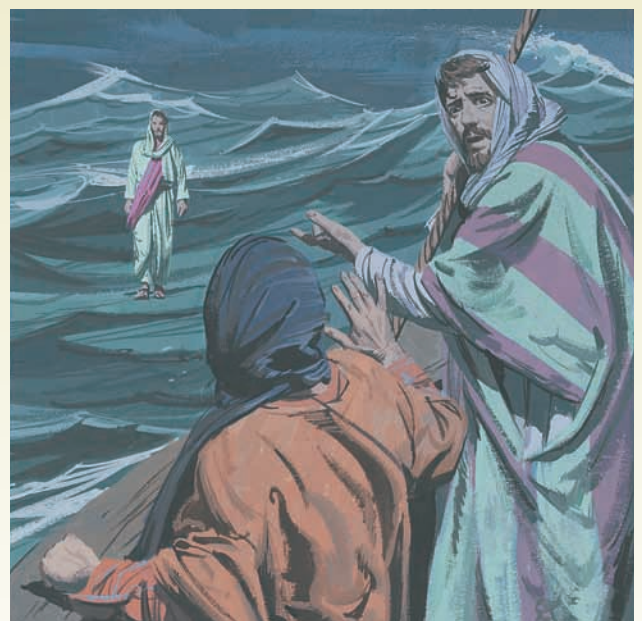

Matthew 14:28–29



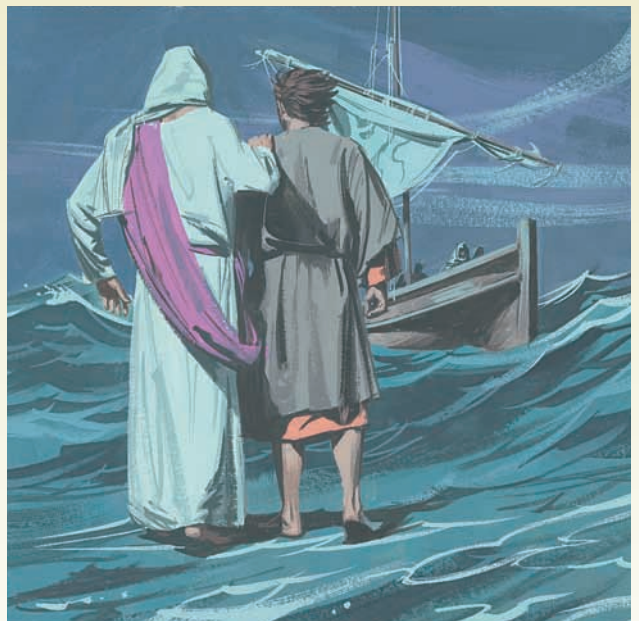
Because the wind was blowing hard, Peter became afraid. He began to sink into the water and cried out to Jesus to save him.
