Creation—Living Creatures

Genesis 1:20-25; Moses 2:20-25; Abraham 4:20-25

And God said, Let the waters bring forth abundantly the moving creature that hath life, and fowl that may fly above the earth... And God said, Let the earth bring forth the living creature after his kind, cattle, and creeping thing, and beast of the earth after his kind. Genesis 1:20, 24

On the fifth day of Creation, the fish and other water creatures were placed in the seas, and the birds were made to fly above the earth (see Genesis 1:20–23; Moses 2:20–23; Abraham 4:20–23).

On the sixth day God put all the other animals upon the earth, creating cattle and beasts and creeping things (see Genesis 1:24–25; Moses 2:24–25; Abraham 4:24–25). God saw that all His creations were good (see Genesis 1:25; Moses 2:25).

Summary

God created the animals on the fifth and sixth days of Creation.
