Why Does King Benjamin Invite Us to Become like a Child?

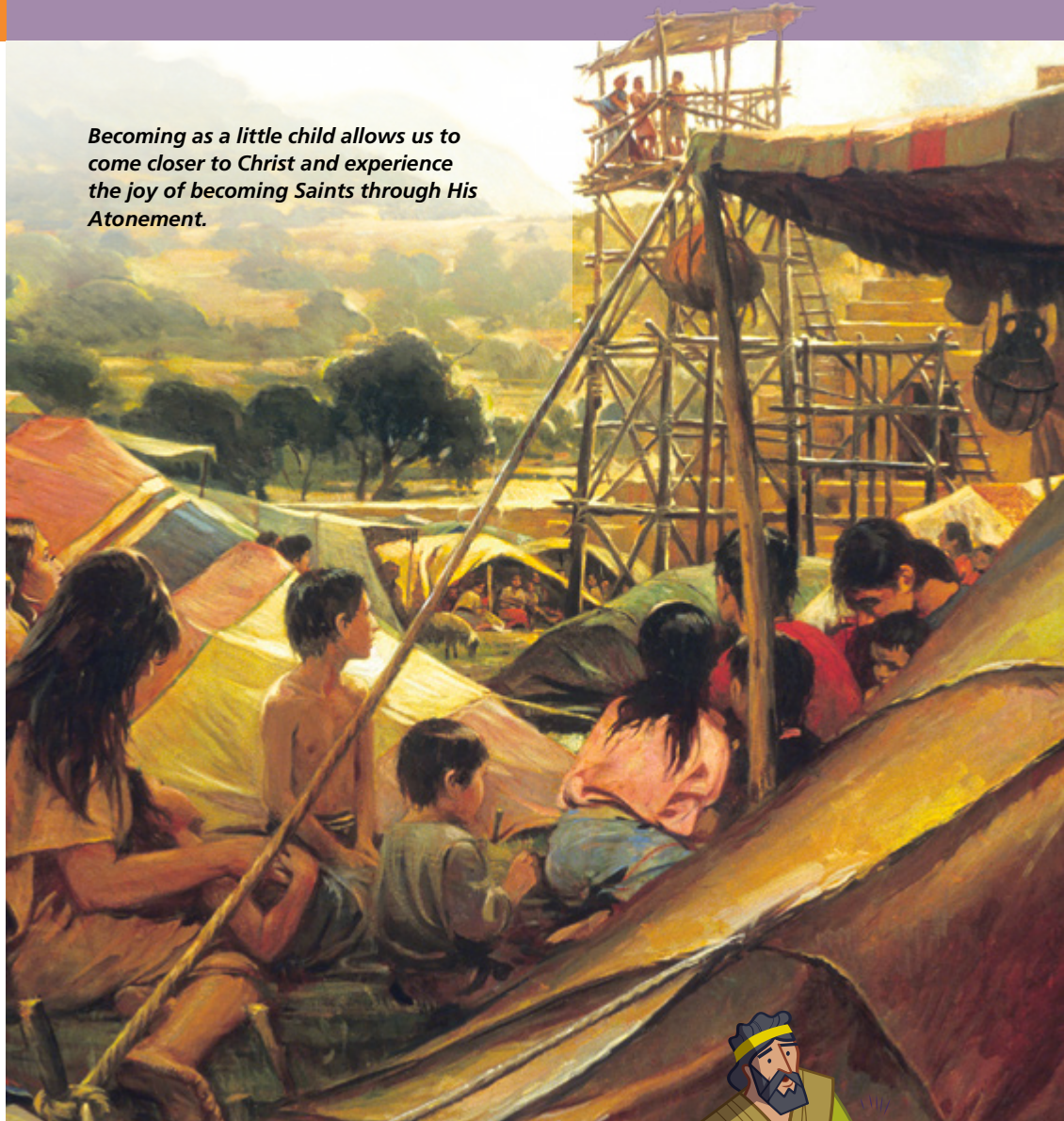
