ACROSS

- 2. When this prophet was young, he tried to lead others away from the Church. Then an angel appeared to him, and he was converted to the gospel (see Mosiah 27:8-24).
- 5. This righteous king built a tower to speak to his people before he died (see Mosiah 2).
- 7. He was a Nephite military leader for most of his life, beginning at age 15 (see Mormon 2, chapter heading).
- 8. He defended King Lamoni's flocks from robbers (see Alma 17:26–39).
- 10. This righteous father led his family from Jerusalem before it was destroyed (see 1 Nephi 1:4-5).

- 1. This Book of Mormon prophet appeared as an angel to Joseph Smith and told him about a book written on gold plates (see Joseph Smith— History 1:33-34).
