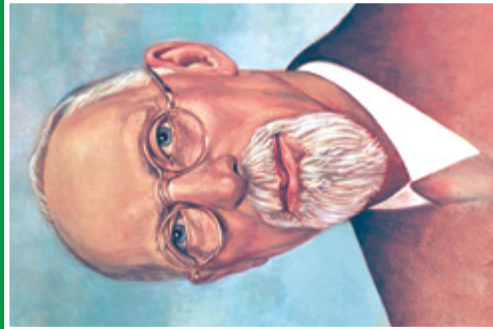


# Prophet Cards

8th President of the Church



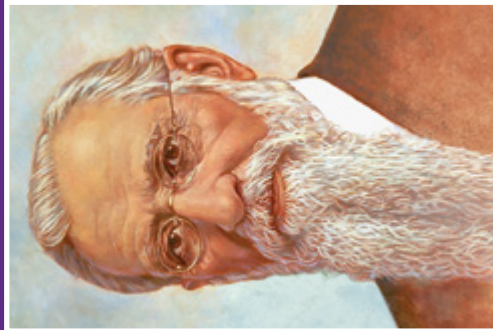
**John Taylor**

7th President of the Church



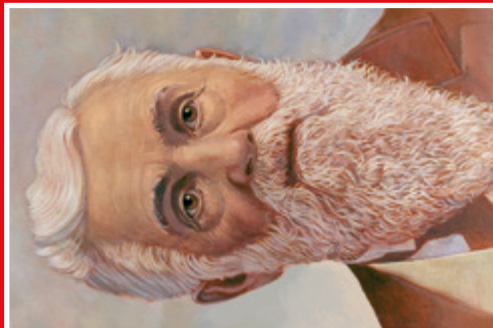
**Brigham Young**







# Prophet Cards

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• He served several missions and baptized thousands of people.</li> <li>• He was Church Historian and wrote in his own journal daily for 63 years.</li> <li>• He dedicated the Salt Lake Temple.</li> </ul> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• He grew up in England.</li> <li>• He sang for Joseph and Hyrum Smith in Carthage Jail.</li> <li>• At the Martyrdom he was shot at several times but still survived.</li> </ul> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• He became an Apostle just three years after joining the Church.</li> <li>• He led the pioneer Saints to Utah.</li> <li>• He began work building the Salt Lake Temple.</li> </ul> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Heavenly Father and Jesus Christ appeared to him when he was 14 years old.</li> <li>• He translated the Book of Mormon from the golden plates.</li> <li>• He directed the Saints to build the Kirtland and Nauvoo temples.</li> </ul> 
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• He had many health challenges, including poor eyesight.</li> <li>• One of his lifelong goals was: "I would be a friend to the friendless and find joy in ministering to the needs of the poor."</li> <li>• As President, he sent humanitarian aid to Europe after World War II.</li> </ul> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• He and his widowed mother didn't have much money, but he once gave his coat to a boy who needed it.</li> <li>• He practiced hard to improve his baseball and handwriting skills.</li> <li>• He was President during the Great Depression.</li> </ul> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• He was the son of Hyrum Smith, and Joseph Smith was his uncle.</li> <li>• At age nine he drove a team of oxen to Utah with his mother and other pioneers.</li> <li>• He was only 15 years old when he began serving a mission in Hawaii.</li> </ul> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• He chose to be baptized after taking a Hebrew class with Joseph Smith.</li> <li>• He almost drowned while going to preach in Hawaii.</li> <li>• He told Church members they would be blessed if they paid their tithing.</li> </ul>



<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• As a boy, he memorized scriptures and hymns while milking cows.</li> <li>• While President, the number of temples doubled.</li> <li>• He received revelation that all worthy men could hold the priesthood.</li> </ul> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The Spirit helped him avoid dangerous situations as a child, like telling him not to explore a run-down shed.</li> <li>• He was a teacher in a one-room schoolhouse.</li> <li>• He helped create the Church Welfare Program.</li> </ul> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• He was the son of President Joseph F. Smith.</li> <li>• As a young man, he drove his mother in a carriage when she needed to take care of women in the neighborhood.</li> <li>• He loved playing sports, especially handball.</li> </ul> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• He was raised on a farm and loved animals all his life.</li> <li>• While serving a mission in Scotland, he saw a carving that became his motto: "What-er thou art, act well thy part."</li> <li>• While he was President, the first stakes were organized outside of North America.</li> </ul> 
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• As a boy, he learned to unselfishly share with those in need.</li> <li>• He was called as a bishop at age 22 and as an Apostle at age 36.</li> <li>• He encouraged Church members to go to the rescue of those who have wandered away from Heavenly Father.</li> </ul> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A walnut tree he planted was used to build the pulpit of the Conference Center.</li> <li>• He presented "The Family: A Proclamation to the World" in 1995.</li> <li>• While he was President, more than 70 temples were dedicated.</li> </ul> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• He earned his Eagle Scout Award at age 15.</li> <li>• When he was young, he played in a band that traveled to Asia on a cruise ship.</li> <li>• He traveled to the Middle East as an Apostle and helped choose the site for the BYU Jerusalem Center.</li> </ul> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• He grew up on a farm and studied agriculture in school.</li> <li>• Before becoming President of the Church, he served as Secretary of Agriculture for the United States government.</li> <li>• He encouraged people to read the Book of Mormon every day.</li> </ul>
