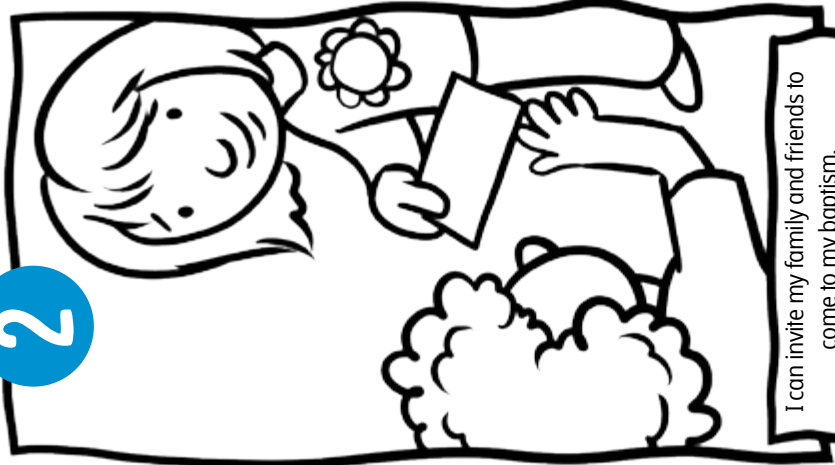
I'm getting baptized! But there are a few things I need to learn first. Help me learn about the steps of baptism by reading and coloring in the boxes below.

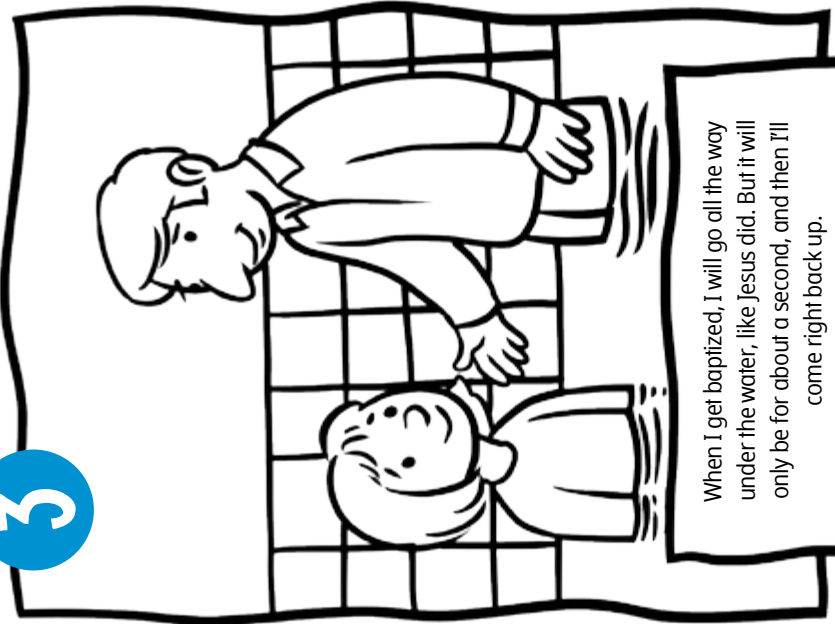

When I get baptized, I will go all the way under the water, like Jesus did. But it will only be for about a second, and then I'll come right back up.

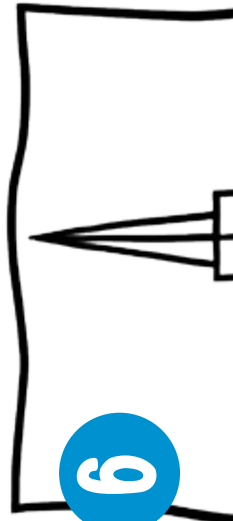

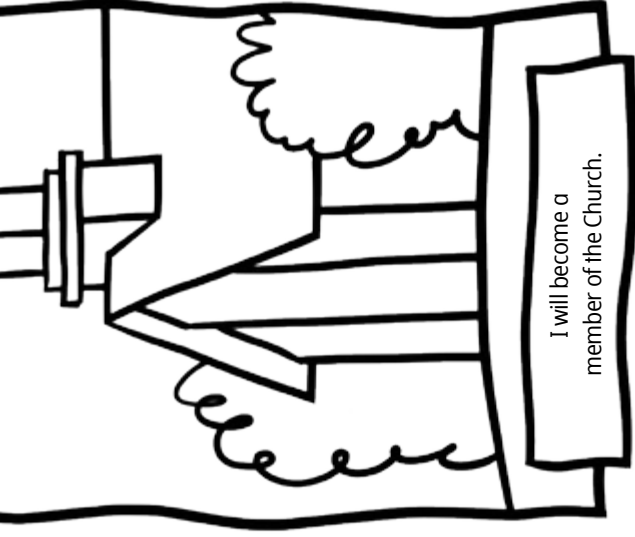




I will take the name of Christ upon me. This means I will be a Christian, or someone who follows Jesus. I'll also promise to always remember Him and obey His commandments.

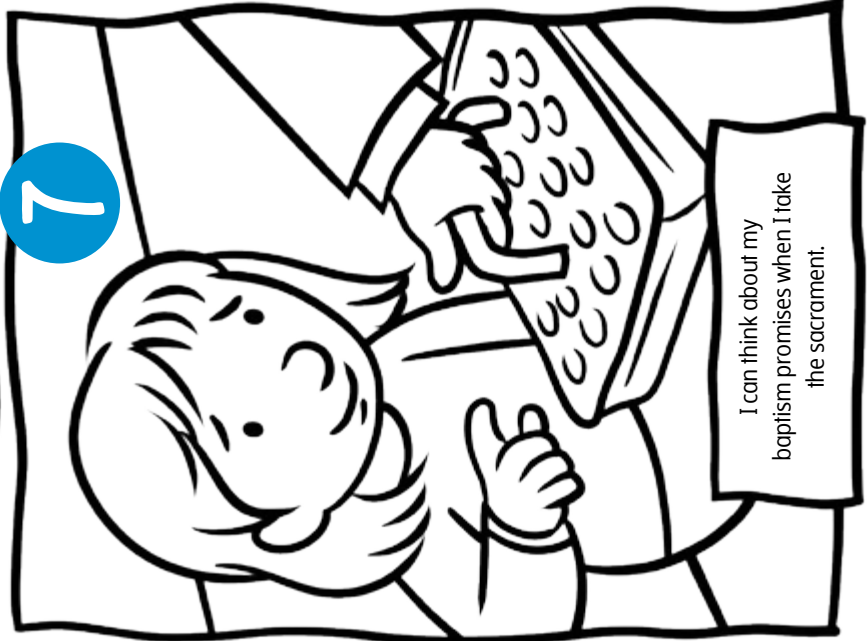


I will be confirmed. That means I will be invited to receive the gift of the Holy Ghost. The Holy Ghost can help me make good choices and warn me about danger.
