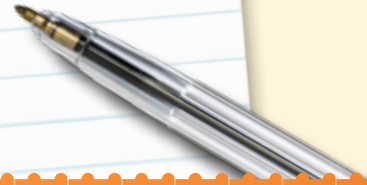


I like learning about the scriptures at church.
