



## Jesus Christ's Example

Jesus Christ said, "Come, follow me."
We can follow Jesus by doing the things
He did. The pictures on the opposite page
show how Jesus encouraged people to have
faith in Him. He taught that it is important
to give thanks for blessings we receive. He
gathered the children around Him so He
could be with them and teach them. Jesus
loved the people He was with and told us to
love our neighbors. With the parable of the
good Samaritan, Jesus taught about loving
others.

A traveler was attacked by thieves and left to die. A priest and then a Levite saw the hurt man, but each of them passed by without helping. Finally, a Samaritan came by and stopped to help the man. He bandaged the man's wounds and took him to an inn. The Samaritan left money with the innkeeper to help care for the man. (See Luke 10:30–37.) This story shows us what it means to follow the commandment to love our neighbors.
