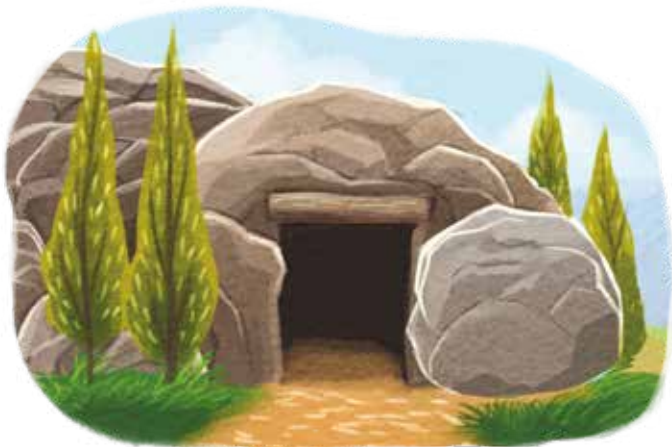
When I was baptized
