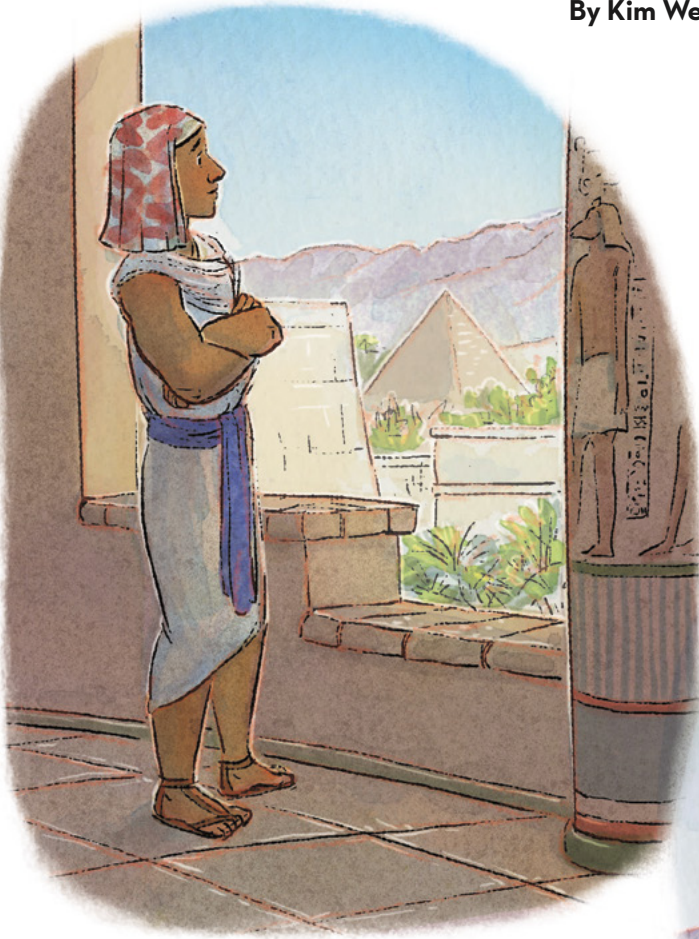


Joseph Forgives His Brothers
