



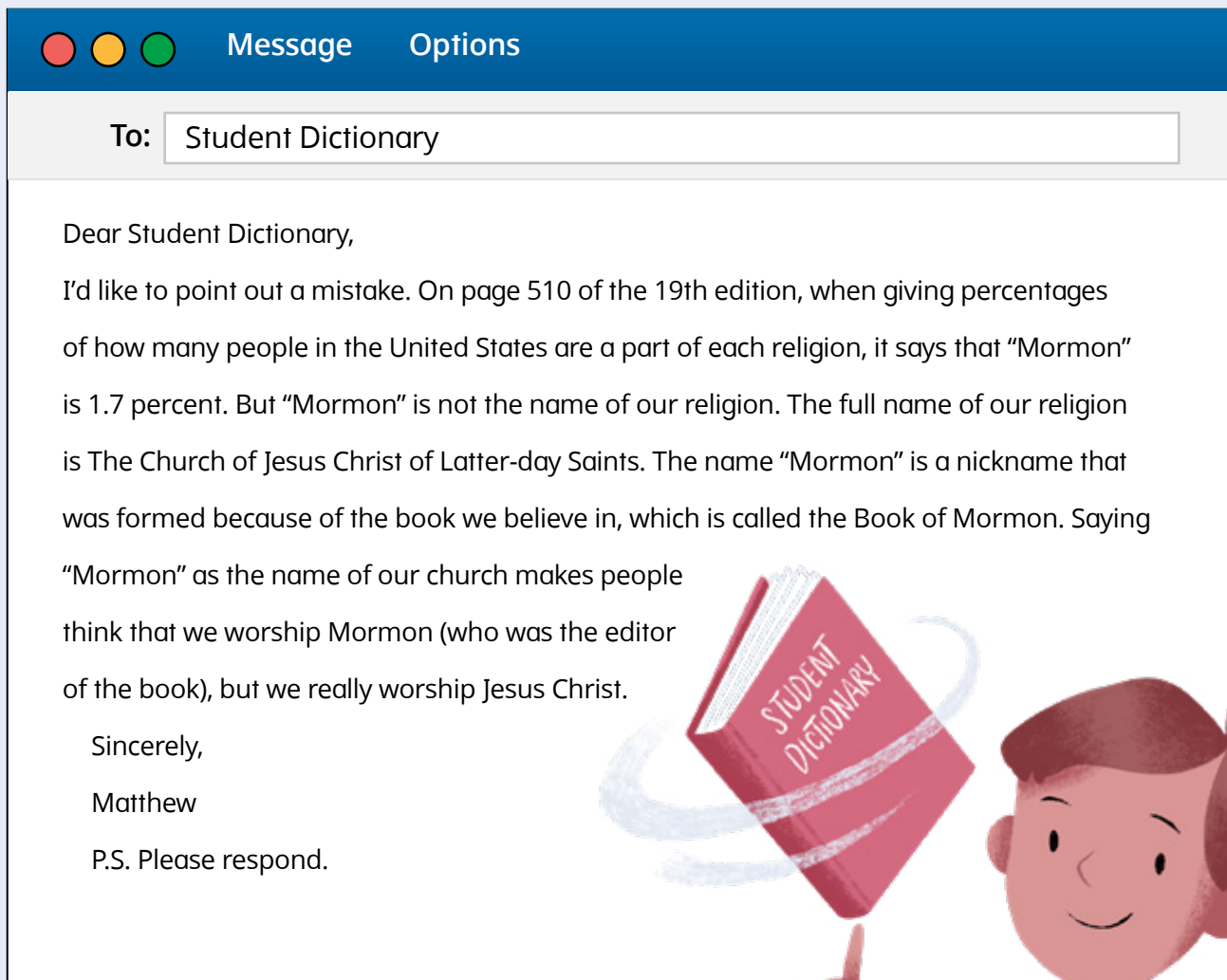
Dear Student Dictionary
