



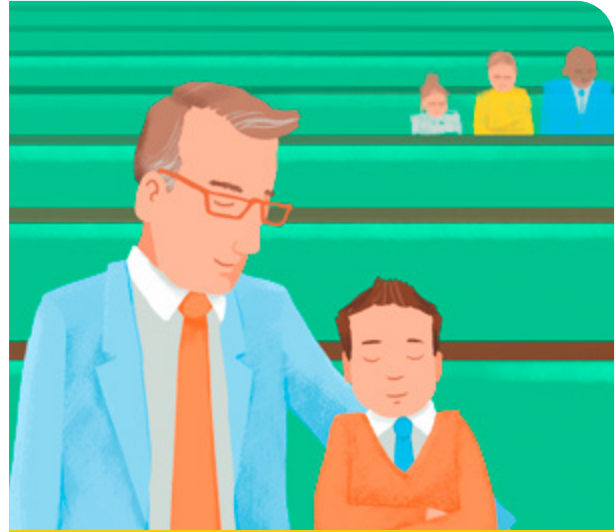

Sing the sacrament hymn.



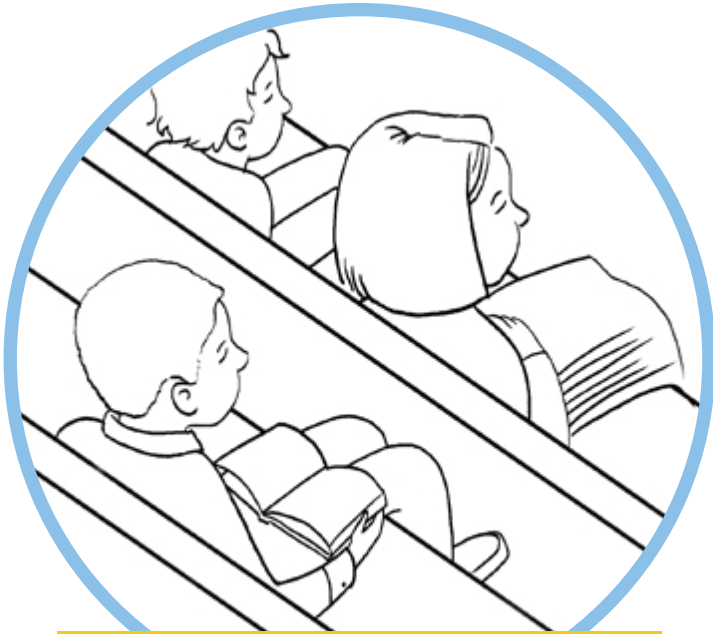
Think about Jesus and promise
