

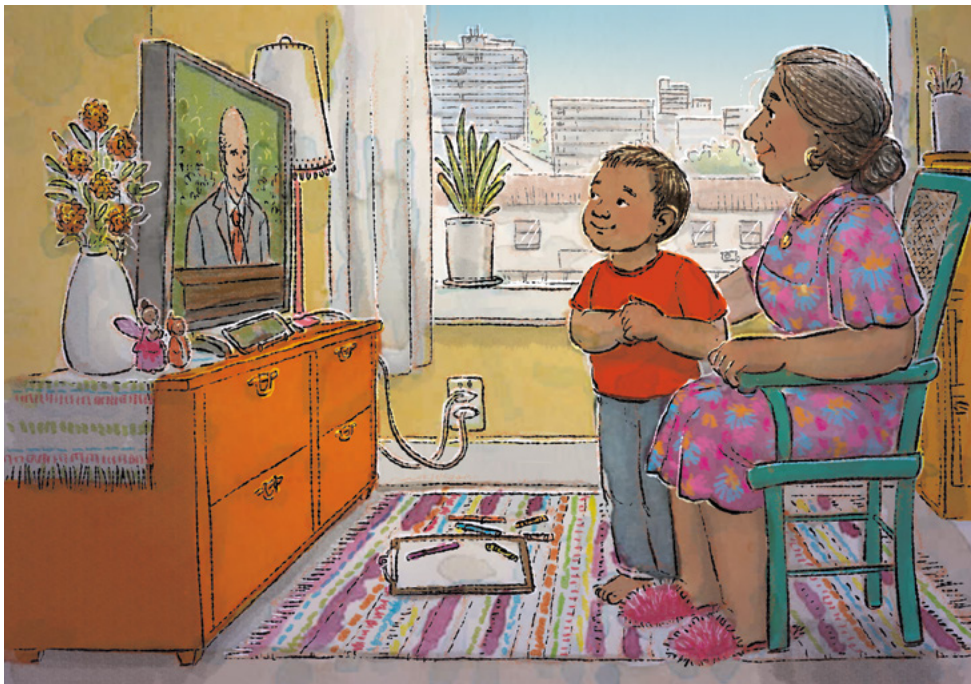
Jesus Christ Named His Church
