## Dress for Success

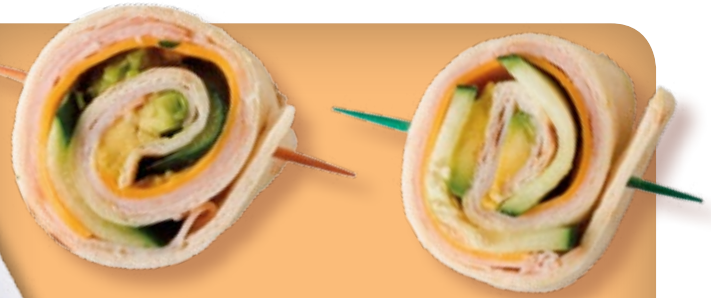
Missionaries dress modestly and neatly. They also take care of the clothes they wear. Ask a parent to help you learn these skills:

**Mending**—Sew a button on a shirt, repair a simple tear or hem, shine scuffs on shoes.

**Laundering**—Separate clothes into similar colors, set the dials on the washer and dryer, add detergent or dryer sheets.

**Ironing**—Carefully select the right iron temperature, use the ironing board.

**Storing**—Hang clothes up or fold them, organize your closet.



## Mix-n-Match Deli Rolls

- 1 flour tortilla
- 3 slices of deli meat, such as turkey or chicken
- 2 slices of cheese, such as mozzarella or cheddar
- 4 thin slices of cucumber
- 4 thin slices of avocado

1. Layer the ingredients on the tortilla.
2. Roll the tortilla up and slice it into pieces. Skewer each roll with a toothpick to hold it together.
3. Try mixing different combinations of meat and cheese and pick which is your favorite.
