Oops! We printed the German flag wrong in the June 2020 *Friend*. Here is the correct flag. We sincerely apologize for the mistake.



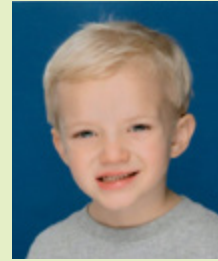
## Staying Healthy and Safe
