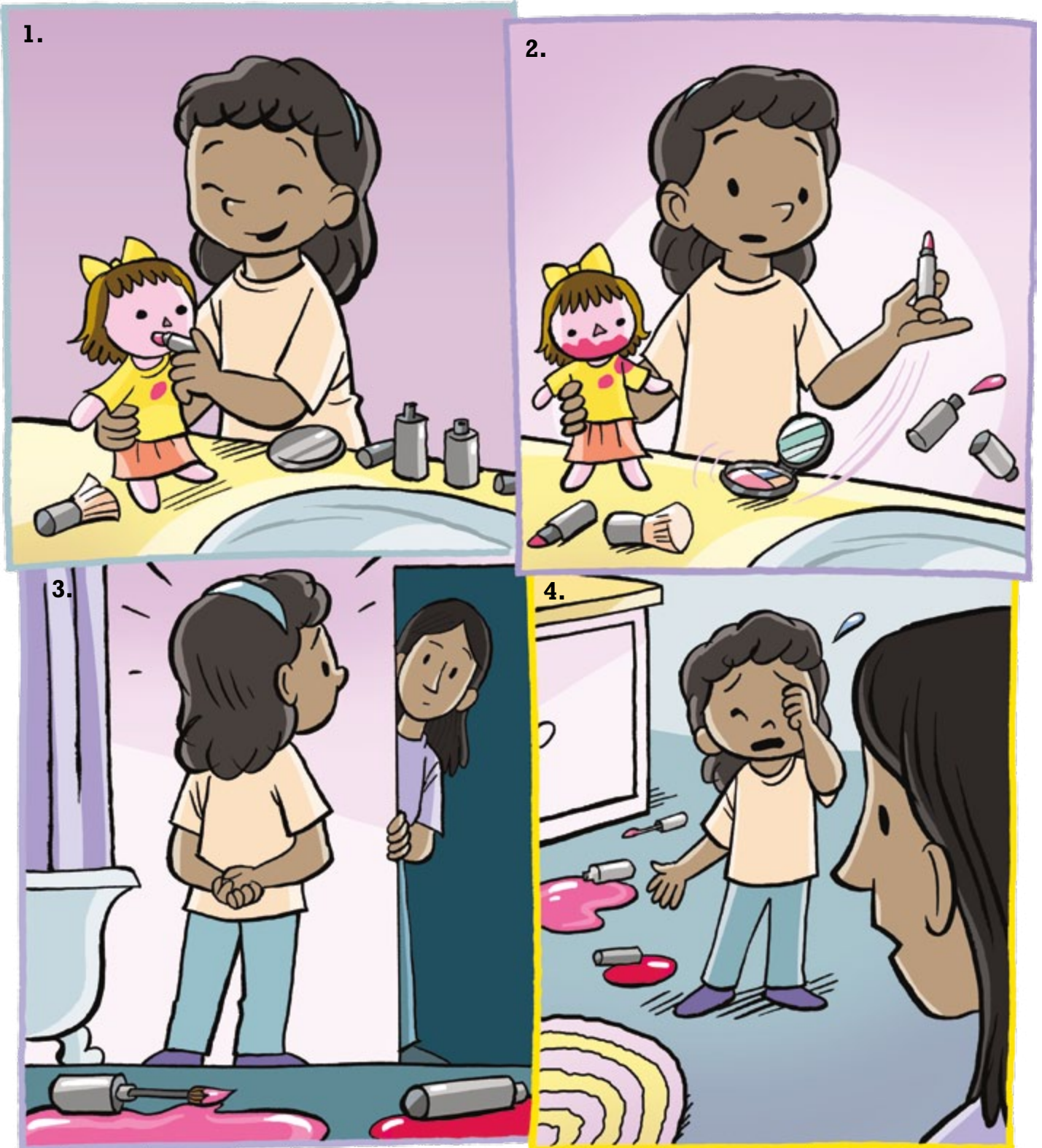


Kelsey Makes a Mistake
