**“Be Wary of Wooden Horses,”** p. 38: Satan has disguised many wooden horses in our day. Read the story of the Trojan horse from the article, and consider going through the books, music, and movies in your home. Make it a game titled “Can This Be Saved?” Keep only the media that is virtuous, lovely, or of good report or praiseworthy (see Articles of Faith 1:13). Conclude by reading Mosiah 5:15 and Doctrine and Covenants 45:32.

**“Help and Be Happy,”** p. F10: Take this opportunity to introduce

or continue a chore chart for your family. List several chores (appropriate to the ages of the children), and ask each person to choose one to do. Read the story, and discuss why it is important for each person to help. Make a goal to serve others during the coming week.
